

MCNEG 2009: Monte Carlo Applications in Radiation Protection and Medicine

MCNEG is the UK forum for users of Monte Carlo radiation transport codes. The 15th annual meeting of MCNEG will be held at St Catherine's College Oxford, UK, between the 30th and 31st of March 2009.

The forum provides delegates with the opportunity to present and discuss their recent applications of Monte Carlo techniques, as well as developments of Monte Carlo radiation transport software. An informal atmosphere is encouraged, with the intention of optimizing feedback and promoting extensive discussions.

- *Medical exposures*
- *Nuclear and related industries*
- *Monte Carlo code development*

Abstracts are invited for oral presentation at the meeting. These should be received by 13th February 2009.

Registration costs £160, which includes the meeting fee, lunches on both days and the conference dinner on Monday 30th March. The fee is payable to MCNEG. Accommodation in St Catherine's College costs an additional £75.90 per person per night.
